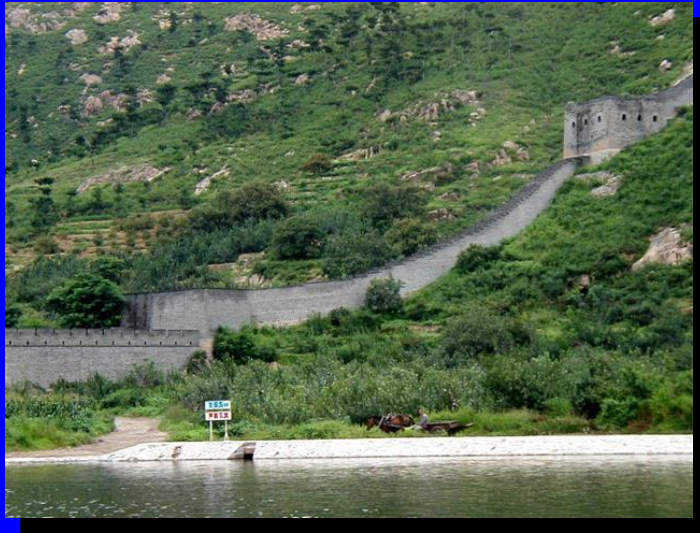

Basic Rules of Landscapes:

“Foreground leads the eye to a focal point, and the eye is held in the picture by a background.”



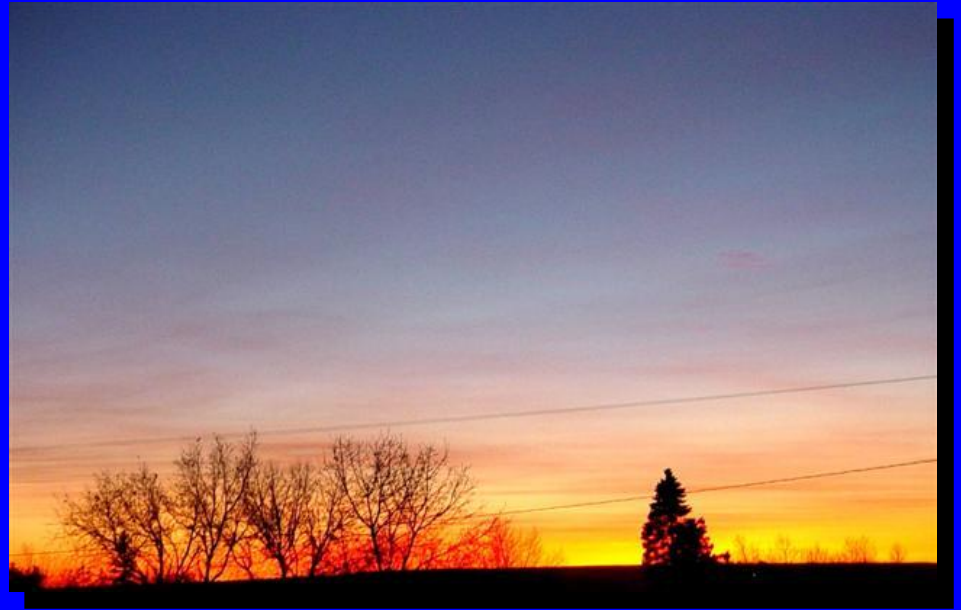
Ingredients of a Landscape:

- Main ingredient for a fantastic landscape is *light*.
- Look for patterns (ploughed fields, crop, mountains, etc).
- A Focal point – a place for the viewers eye to go.



Light You Say?

- Light has a *huge* impact of patterns.
- Early morning & late afternoon produce the *best* light.
- Creates drama on the sky – storm clouds & a beam of sun or Contrast – bright blue sky, shimmering green grass
